

## COVID-19 UPDATE: APRIL 3, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 14: 3/29/2020 - 4/4/2020



To date, a total of 311 patients in San Benito County have been tested for COVID-19 at eight reporting laboratories. Of these, 265 have tested negative for COVID-19 and 23 are pending results. Fifty-eight percent (179) of patients tested were female. Patients ages ranged from 3 years to 99 years (median: 46 years). San Benito County Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of April 3, 2020, there have been a total of 23 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in San Benito County; 11 cases remain active. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Eleven patients have recovered and are no longer considered active cases in San Benito County. One death has been reported in San Benito County during week 12. All results included in this update are current to April 3, 2020 at 2:30PM.


